## Senators Steamroll the Badgers

LITTLE ROCK - The Badger football team visited the Robinson Senators Friday night October 14th and came away on the short side of things, losing the ball game 37-16.

The Badgers took the opening kickoff on their own 20-yard line and in one play, Kiandrea Barker got the ball out to nearly the 45yard line of Beebe on a power run. A penalty on Robinson moved the ball to mid field. On the next play -Zach Grant threw an interception that was fumbled back to the Badgers on the Senators 13-yard line. The Badgers ran 2 running plays and then Grant hit Jayden Smith in the end zone for a short touchdown pass. With the extra point, the Badgers lead was 7-0 at the 9:34 mark in the 1st quarter. On the next play, the Badgers recovered their one side kick on the kick off and looked to be back in business on the Robinson 45-

yard line. The Badgers were held to three and out and had to punt back to the Senators. With 8:09 remaining in the 1st quarter, the Senators took over on their 20-yard line and began to drive down the field. Two runs later, the Senators were at mid field. On several more scrambles, the Senators had made their way to the Badger 25-yard line with under 5:00 remaining in the 1st quarter. The Senators continued to run straight up the Badger defense and after a few more rushes - a QB sneak scored the Senators first touchdown of the night and with the extra point, the game was tied at the 2:36


mark in the 1st quarter. After a great return by Brayden Sanders to the Senator 45-yard line - the Badgers lost yards on several runs and had to punt the ball back to the Senators at the .43 mark of the 1st quarter, the Senators began the next drive on their own 4yard line. After a few quick runs, the Senators moved the ball out to their 18-vard line to end the quarter knot-

ted up 7-7. The Senators had a couple of short runs and after a penalty moved the ball back to the 15-yard yard line Robinson was looking at 1st and 21. The Badger defense stood tall and forced 4th down and a punt from the Senators to the Badger 28yard line. A pass interference call moved the ball to the Badger 44-yard line. After several plays for no yards, the punt team headed to the field. Javden Smith punted to the Senator 22yard line at the 7:26 mark of the 1st half. After taking over on their own 22-yard line, the Senators were unable to move the ball against the Badger defense and punted back to Beebe at the 5:39 mark of the 1st half. The Badgers took over and after a couple of short runs, Grant hit Brenton Brasfield on the Senator 33-yard line for a 1st down. Beebe was called for a personal foul making it 3rd down and 18 to go. After a long pass and personal foul against the

Senators - the Badgers took

over on the Senators 13yard line. After not being able to move the ball - the Badgers Andy Rodriguez was true on a 22-yard field goal making it 10-7 with .47

remaining in the first half. After the kickoff to the Robinson 44-yard line - the Senators wasted little time moving the ball down the field, after a couple of quick hitch pass plays, the Senators moved the ball to the Badger 43-yard line. After a personal foul on the Badgers, the Senators took over on the Badger 20-yard line. The Senators kicked a field goal from 32-yards out to end the half with the score tied 10-10.

Robinson took the opening kick off to start the second half. The Senators took over at mid field and wasted little time scoring. Four runs later the Senators were in the Badger endzone and with the extra point led 17-10. After the kickoff - the Badgers started on their 20vard line at the 10:26 mark of the 3rd quarter. The Badgers mixed up the short pass and run play offense, to move the ball down the field to their own 46-yard line,Grant then connected on a short 4th down pass to Smith, at the Senator 46yard line, giving the Badgers a 1st down. The Badgers were unable to move the ball on four downs and after an incomplete pass and penalty, the Badgers turned the ball over, giving the Senators the ball back on their own 25-yard line. The Senators passed down to the Badger 20-yard line, with an unsportsmanlike penalty on the Badgers, the Senators took over at the Beebe 10yard line. Three running plays later, Robinson scored a touchdown, making the score 24-10 lead with the extra point, at the 3:15 mark

of the 3rd quarter. After the kickoff, the Badgers started on their own 20-yard line. On the first play from scrimmage, Kiandrea Barker fumbled the ball back to Robinson at the 2:53 mark of the 3rd quarter at the Badger 25-yard line. The Badger defense stood tall and held the Senators on four plays and took over on their own 18-yard line. Skylar Richardson took the following hand off on the next play and fumbled back to



Robinson on the Badger 25yard line. One play later, the Senators found the end zone again on a beautiful pass and catch. The extra point was no good, making the score 30-10 with 90 seconds remaining in the third quar-

The Badgers took over at their 40-yard line with Smith under center. Beebe had several timely runs and passes down field and found themselves on the Robinson 2-yard line with 7:00 remaining in the game. Smith scored a touchdown on 3rd down on a short run and with the missed extra point, the final score was set at 37-16, as Robinson worked their way to midfield with 3:00 remaining, the Badger defense was able to hold one last time - the Badgers were unable to move the ball the final three minutes and the game ended with a 37-16
