**ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01**

**AN ORDINANCE TO WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, Arkansas Code Annotated §14-58-303 require competitive bidding for the purchase by the City of Beebe, Arkansas, of supplies, apparatus, equipment, materials, and services the cost of which is excess of \$35,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Beebe, Arkansas, must have police vehicles with necessary accessories in its possession for use on a daily basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Beebe, Arkansas, therefore is presently in need of a police vehicle (the "Vehicle") to be accessorized for emergency services, the cost of which may exceed \$35,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the City Council for the City of Beebe, Arkansas, that due to the limited in supply stock placing the matter for bid would unduly delay the purchase of the Vehicle and would likely result in the City of Beebe not obtaining the best vehicle necessary which could be accessorized for the purposes needed; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Beebe has contracted several suppliers regarding the purchase of the Vehicle and the City Council for the City of Beebe has determined that there exists one (1) supplier, namely Frank Fletcher CDJR, located in Jonesboro, Arkansas, which has on hand the specific type of vehicle which can be accessorized as needed and wanted by the City of Beebe, Arkansas; and

**WHEREAS**, it has, therefore, been determined by the City Council for the City of Beebe, Arkansas, that competitive bidding, therefore, is not feasible or practical;

Department of Human Services Announces  
USDA Household Commodity Programs

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

(LITTLE ROCK, Ark.) – The Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education (DCCCEE) within the Arkansas Department of Human Services (DHS) operates the Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) and the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) for Arkansas. DHS operates these United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) programs through partnership with Regional Food Banks and Community Action Agencies throughout the State to provide nutritious food services to families in need.

The TEFAP program is available in all 75 Arkansas counties. A variety of nutritious, high-quality food is made available by USDA to the State for distribution to needy families. Eligibility requirements are based on residency, income, and household size. If the household is SNAP eligible, they are TEFAP eligible. Foster children are categorically eligible for the program. The CSFP program is available in 40 Arkansas counties. Eligibility requirements are based on age (must be 60+ years of age), residency, income, and household size. New applicants may anticipate being placed on a waiting list. The CSFP food package contains a variety of nutritious food to eligible seniors. These services are provided in accordance with Federal Civil Rights Laws and USDA rights, regulations, and policies. USDA, its agencies, offices, employees, and institutions, participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, sex, disability, age, reprisal, or retaliation for prior civil rights activity in any program conducted or funded by USDA.

1. That it is not feasible or practical to require competitive bidding for the procurement of a police vehicle with the necessary accessories from the Frank Fletcher CDJR by the City of Beebe, Arkansas, as defined by Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-58-303 and as held by the Supreme Court of Arkansas in *Klinger v. City of Fayetteville*, 293 Ark. 128, 732, S.W. 2d 859 (1987).

2. That, therefore, the requirement of competitive bidding for the present procurement by the City of Beebe, Arkansas, of the following equipment:

One (1) New Dodge Durango, White Police Vehicle, as set forth in more detail in the Retail Order For A Motor Vehicle and Order Summary attached hereto and incorporated collectively herein as Exhibit "1".

3. That the Mayor and Clerk of the City of Beebe, Arkansas, shall have the authority, given the necessary and requisite authority to contract on behalf of the City of Beebe, Arkansas, of said Vehicle and to sign necessary documents on behalf of the City of Beebe, Arkansas, without further action of the Council,

4. That the procurement of the Vehicle with accessories is necessary for the health and safety of the Citizens of the City of Beebe, Arkansas, and emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
