Badgers Jump Back into Conference Play

After a complete week of weather cancellations, both Badger squads were able to get back on the hardwood this past week.

On Tuesday night January 23rd both squads traveled to Jacksonville to face the Titans. In girls action, the Lady Badgers tipped off against the Lady Titans to start the action. The Lady Badgers started hitting their shots early on the Lady Titans and did not stop all night - as they jumped out to a commanding 22-4 first quarter lead and led 38-9 at halftime. Coach Riley was able to substitute several players in the second half as the ladies led 45-10 after the third quarter and finished off the Lady Titans in the fourth quarter, winning the contest easily, 48-16.

Tuesday night boys action saw the Badgers face off against the Titans - It was an evenly played first quarter, with the Badgers leading 10-9 at the end of the quarter. The game remained tight throughout the second quarter, with the Badgers holding a slim, 21-18 lead at halftime. The Titans came storming back with relentless defense in the third period, The Titans outscored the Badgers 17-6 in the third quarter to take a 35-27 lead going into the final stanza. The Titans kept their foot on the gas in the final stanza to escape with a 13-point victory over the Badgers, 53-40.

Wednesday night January 24th Parkview visited the

Badgers at Badger Arena in a make up game. In girls action, the Lady Patriots trailed the Lady Badgers 14-10 after the first quarter of play. The Lady Badgers outscored the Lady Patriots 13-5 in the second period, taking a 12-point lead into halftime, 27-15. The Lady Patriots came out of the locker room with purpose in the third quarter, out scoring the Lady Badgers 12-8 in the period, to cut the Lady Badgers lead to 35-27 going into the fourth quarter. Both teams gave it their all in the fourth quarter, with the Lady Patriots going on a 23 point run between the third and fourth quarter, giving them the momentum to top the Lady Badgers in the end, 50-46.

In the night cap, the Badgers and Patriots played an even first quarter, with the Badgers leading 13-12 after one quarter of play. The Badgers outscored the Patriots 13-10 in the second period to give the Badgers a 26-22 lead at the break. The Patriots came out on fire in the third stanza - outscoring the Badgers 17-8 in the period to take a slim 39-38 lead into the fourth quarter. The Badger could not contain the Patriots in the fourth quarter - with Parkview out scoring the Badgers 23-9 in the period to take home a 62-49 victory over the Badgers.

Friday night January 26th - the Private schools visited Badger Arena. In girls action - the Lady Badgers faced Mt. Saint Mary. The Lady Badgers led from wire

to wire, as they led 16-8 after the first period and 21-17 at half time. MSM could not handle the physical inside play as the Lady Badgers pushed their lead to 40-26 after three quarters of play. The Lady Badgers played most of their second team in the fourth quarter, as they won going away, 48-30.

The Lady Badgers now stand at 13-10 overall and 6-1 in 5-A Central Conference play.

In the late game Friday night - the Badgers faced the Catholic Rockets - and the rockets shot out of the shoot quickly Friday night - hitting several early 3-pointers, to take a 16-4 first quarter lead and continued to pour it on on in the second period, dominating the Badgers in all phases of the game, to lead 30-7 at half time. The second half did not go the Badgers way, as the Rockets continued to roll to a 39-18 third quarter lead and continued their hot shooting in the final stanza - to take home a 55-24 victory over the Badgers.

The Badgers now stand at 6-11 overall and 0-5 in 5-A Central play.

Road games all week this week - with both squads traveling to Little Rock to face LRCA Tuesday January 30th at 6 p.m. and will travel to Sherwood to face Sylvan Hills High school Wednesday January 31st at 6 p.m.
