in public and private non-profit two-year and four-year colleges and universities the following higher education institutions located within the State that are certified according to criteria established by the General

Assembly (A) A public or private nonprofit two-year or four-year college or

university; (B) A public or private vocational-technical school; or (C) A public or private technical institute.

(2) The General Assembly shall establish criteria to determine who is eligible to receive the scholarships and grants pursuant to this Amendment.
