NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that a Special Election will be held in the City of Beebe Arkansas (the "City") on November 5, 2024, at which there shall be submitted to the electors the following questions:

1. The adoption of a 0.50% local sales and use tax within the City, the net collections of which remaining after deduction of the administrative charges of the State of Arkansas and required rebates will be used for one or more of the following: (a) to acquire, construct, improve, expand, equip, furnish, operate and maintain park and recreational facilities; and (b) to pay and secure the repayment of bonds approved by the voters issued by the City from time to time to finance park and recreational facilities. The levy of the tax is not dependent on any bonds being approved or issued.

2. The issuance of bonds of the City in one or more series in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$13,940,000 to finance all or a portion of the costs of acquiring, constructing and equipping park and recreational facilities, including particularly, without limitation, a new ball complex, and any necessary land acquisition and parking, landscaping, signage, drainage, lighting, road and utility improvements related thereto and, in order to pay the bonds, the pledge as collateral of a 0.50% local sales and use tax levied within the City by Ordinance No. 2024-14, adopted July 22, 2024 (the "Tax") if separately approved by the voters. Collections of the Tax no necessary to pay the bonds may be used for purposes as approved from time to time by the voters.

Only qualified electors of the City will have the right to vote and the electors may vote either for or against each question as described above. The election will be held between the hours of 7:30 o'clock a.m. and 7:30 o'clock p.m. on November 5, 2024. Early voting times and locations and polling places for November 5, 2024 will be announced and proclaimed by the White County Election Commission.

Arkansas Weekly Gas Price Update

Average gasoline prices in Arkansas have fallen 5.7 cents per gallon in the last week, averaging \$2.88/g today, according to GasBuddy's survey of 1,826 stations in Arkansas. Prices in Arkansas are 14.5 cents per gallon lower than a month ago and stand 57.9 cents per gallon lower than a year ago. The national average price of diesel has declined 4.5 cents in the last week and stands at \$3.62 per gallon- the lowest since early 2022.

According to GasBuddy price reports, the cheapest station in Arkansas was priced at \$2.49/g yesterday while the most expensive was \$3.80/g, a difference of \$1.31/g. The lowest price in the state yesterday was \$2.49/g while the highest was \$3.80/g, a difference of \$1.31/g.

The national average price of gasoline has fallen 7.2 cents per gallon in the last week, averaging \$3.22/g today. The national average is down 22.5 cents per gallon from a month ago and stands 58.8 cents per gallon lower than a year ago, according to GasBuddy data compiled from more than 11 million weekly price reports covering over 150,000 gas stations across the country.
